Andre Matthew Wallace Scholarship

The Zeta Psi Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. has established a memorial scholarship in honor of Andre Matthew Wallace in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000). This scholarship is given in the honor of the late Andre Matthew Wallace and will be awarded to a deserving graduating senior going to a Technical School or Community College.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior and have taken and received a minimum score of one of the following: ACT Score- 18, Accuplacer -Reading 256, Writing 256, Math 237.
2. Applicant must have a minimum grading average of 2.5 on a 4.0 grading scale.
3. Applicant must be a United States citizen graduating from a school in either Allen, Beauregard, Calcasieu, Cameron, or Jeff Davis Parish and must have been accepted for admission by a technical school or a two year community college of their choice. Proof of acceptance to the school must be sent to the committee upon notice in order to receive the scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Download and complete the Scholarship Application from the website at Zetapsilambda.com
2. Essay must be three paragraphs typed 12pt. Times New Roman font - 1" margins. The topic is state why you feel that you would be a worthy recipient of the Andre Matthew Wallace Memorial Scholarship.
3. Request official high school transcript of seven (7) semesters.
4. Submit a wallet size photograph to the application.
5. Refer to the directions on page three (3) for the submission process.
6. Applicants submit application, school acceptance letter, picture, essay and test scores electronically to the Zeta Psi Lambda site.
7. Have school send official transcript to zetapsilambda1906@gmail.com or P.O. Box 1102, Lake Charles, LA 70602-1102. Mailed transcripts must be received no later then 3 days after the deadline (April 18, 2026).

Process for Submitting Documents
